Title: **TRAPUNTO CRAZY QUILT BY MACHINE**

Full Day Class

Description: Pattern (heart) provided to work in a new and exciting way to create “crazy” patch work with your machine that is “trapuntoed” (is that a word????).

Learn new ways to embellish by machine with exciting thread work. Further embellishing can be done with buttons, beads, lace, ribbons, charms, and so forth (embellishing done after class).

Finished *samples* will be shared with the class. A short demonstration by teacher will be given on beading. Students will embellish as time permits (see supply list).

Class Limit: 20 students. The limit is necessary so I can assist every student.

Supplies: Bring to class your sewing machine, all feet (especially darning foot), needles (universal and embroidery (90/14)), and instruction book for your machine (we may have to play with tension a bit). Bring also several empty bobbins.

Bring a beading needle and thread if you want to try your hand at beading.

Bring different colored threads for machine thread work (rayon threads are especially beautiful to use). Bring *invisible thread* or water soluble thread.

Bring a lot of *scrap fabrics* and please be willing to share (please don't bring your whole stash – the finished piece will only be approx. 14” x 14”). Background fabric (black), interfacing and Wonder Under and batting will be provided.

If you have a portable light box, please bring it and be willing to share it with the class. I have my own and will share it. A window can be used to transfer design.

Bring small ironing surface (pad) and iron. If you have a Clover Mini Iron, that would be very sufficient for this workshop. Extension cords could prove to be handy.

Machiner gloves or something to make your fingers tacky. I will bring some gloves for sale to class. Cost: \$8.64

Supply Fee: \$5 – to cover cost of pattern, background fabric, interfacing and Wonder Under. I will bring some threads to share.
